Library is not a place of books but it is a place of wisdom. Our librarian entitled and named with a great thinker Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru.

Library Facilities

- Library is enriched with more than 8600 books, 20 National Journals, 30 Magazines, 100 CD's and 7 Newspapers. It has seating capacity of 300 students at a time.
- Library is equipped with newly materials and services and automated with advanced software.
- library has 4 Computers with Internet facility and one photocopier machine for photocopy.
- The library is opened on all the working days i.e. from 09.00 a.m. to 04.00 p.m.
- All students and staff can borrow or return books on all working days during the working hours.
- However the provision to open the library on Sunday & holiday is made for special circumstances such as examination preparations, seminar, work shop organization etc.
- Library has a book bank facility for students during the examinations, tests etc.

Library Rules

- 1. Before entering the library, personal belongings of the readers must be kept at the entrance.
- 2. Librarian may recall any books from the borrower at any time after issue.
- 3. There is an over due charge of Rs. 1/– (Rupee One) per day on every book beyond the allowed lending period.
- 5. A person losing or damaging library books repeatedly shall be debarred from using the library.

- Upon any infringement of the library rules, members shall forfeit the privileges of admission and membership of the library.
- 7. A borrower shall replace a book if it is lost while in custody.
- In case borrower fails to replace a lost or damaged book within a month from the due date of its return, he/she shall pay to the library the full cost of the book.
- The reference books, journals and etc. shall not be issued. In special cases, the librarian at his/her discretion may issue a reference book for a short period.

College Rules & Regulations

- Students are required to carry their identity card, issued by the institute at all times, while they are
 in the institute.
- Students are required to attend lecture regularly. At least 75% attendance is compulsory for B.Ed. & 80% for D.Ed. students to appear in final examination.
- During the period of course students must not attend or take part in any government, anti college
 or subversive activities.
- This is full time course. The students are, therefor, not allowed to study for any other examination during the period of the course.
- If a student remains absent for his/her classes for seven working days continuously, his/her name will be struck off the college rolls, irrespective of the fact that he/she has paid his/her dues.
- Strict action will be taken against those students who found involved in strike or any other illigle
- Students who desire to leave the college at any stage during the course, will have to deposit fee for the balance period of course before leaving the college.



Important Instructions for Admission in B.Ed. course:

- The admission to B.Ed./D.Ed. (Regular) course will be made on the basis of marks obtained in the Qualifying Examination. The minimum eligibility criteria for admission in B.Ed./D.Ed. Courses is 50% for general candidates and 47.5% for SC/ST candidates in their qualifying examination.
- In case a candidate has passed the Master Degree Examination also alongwith Bachelor Degree, the higher percentage of marks obtained in either of the two will be taken into consideration while preparing the merit (for only B.Ed. Course).
- It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure eligibility for admission before applying for the course.

Documents / Certificates to be attached with the Admission Form

- a) Matric, 10+2, B.A.-I, II, III, PG Qualifying exam. certificate (if any).
- b) Character Certificate from the Head of the institution last attended.
- Gap Year Certificate (if any gap during study).
- d) Migration Certificate (for other university candidate).
- e) 10 passport size colour photographs.
- f) Haryana Domicile (for candidates of Haryana state only).
- g) Caste (SC/BC/OBC) Certificate.
- h) Medical Certificate (only for D.Ed.).
